Improve student ability to explain and respond orally, in writing and using digital technologies.

Achieve the following long term goals.

- 80% students achieving A-C in English, Maths and Science.
- 25% students achieving results in the U2B (Upper Two Bands) in most NAPLAN areas.
- 20% students achieving results in the U2B in writing.

Our initiatives include

- *Reduce the teaching areas of classroom teachers to English, Maths, HASS (Humanities and Social Sciences) and The Arts to facilitate a sharper and narrower focus on priority areas.*
- *Establish Science and Technologies as specialist teaching areas to develop consistency, rigor and higher achievement.*
- *Digital literacies and ICT skills will be formally taught by a specialist as part of a whole school program to ensure students can successfully complete assessment requirements.*
- *Use professional learning circles to share and celebrate best practice particularly in pedagogy, data analysis/action plans, collaboration, and moderation.*
- *Organise NCT to release all HUB teachers for 2 hours each week to collaboratively analyse data, plan for quality differentiation and teaching and learning programs, pre and post moderation.*
- *Purchase resources to support implementation of the Whole School Curriculum, Pedagogy and Assessment Plan.*
- *Provide professional development in "Age Appropriate Pedagogies" and "Art and Science of Teaching" to enhance student engagement in learning.*
- *Enhancing the learning environments of all students to aid and maximise productivity and learning outcomes.*


